## The Seven Wise Virtues Civil Service Examination

Now that you have spent several days pondering the wisdom of Confucius it is time to show your understanding of virtue. Complete the three examination preparation levels below and you will be well on your way to creating your own wise words for others to follow.

<b>District:</b> Create a list of the seven virtues you deem most worthy in the spaces below:	<b>Provincial:</b> Define each of your chosen virtues in your own words AND create a symbol for each virtue.	<b>Palace:</b> Provide a relevant and personally meaningful example for each of your chosen virtues. You <b>MUST</b> use at least <b>FOUR</b> different types of sources. *

\* Sources can be: books, poems, songs, interviews, films, quotes or stories from a family member or friend, etc. See me for additional ideas. **YOU MAY ONLY USE TWO INTERNET SOURCES AND ALL SOURCES MUST BE DOCUMENTED.**

Once you have completed your examination preparation, you are ready to tackle your first, and most important, assignment. So, here it is:

Create a document (a.k.a wisdom product) with a page/portion dedicated to each of your chosen virtues. Your wisdom can be in the form of a scroll, book, comic strip, journal, sketchbook, recipe box, coupon folder, foldable, etc.

On each page provide your definition for the virtue, your symbol for the virtue, your well written personally meaningful example, and your documented source.

Please be creative and thoughtful. Also, please proofread, edit, and spellcheck so your wisdom will be passed down, error free, for generations to come.
